## **Crown Counsel and Judge Complaint**

Thank you for your letter of February 3, 2021, addressed to the Honourable David Eby, Attorney General and Minister Responsible for Housing, regarding the conduct of Crown Counsel and the judge in your current legal matter. I am responding on behalf of the Attorney General, as the Deputy Attorney General of British Columbia.

In your letter you describe comments and actions made by Crown Counsel, as well as the presiding judge in your case. While I appreciate the time that you have taken to write, the Ministry of Attorney General cannot speak to matters presently before the courts, nor do we have the authority to investigate complaints about judges. Under our system of law, the judicial branch of government is separate and independent from the executive branch of government. The independence of the judiciary from the executive and legislative branches of government is a fundamental principle of our democracy.

Any concerns regarding the conduct—as opposed to a ruling—of a Provincial Court Judge may be submitted to the Chief Judge of the Provincial Court of British Columbia, as their office handles all complaints regarding the conduct of Judicial Officers of the Provincial Court.
